There are three options to upload your footage to St Stephens, depending on whether you use iCloud (iPhones), Google Cloud (android phones), or our own dedicated server (any device).

### Upload to our own server (NextCloud)

This server is hosted at the Vicarage and it is located at <a href="http://halfang.duckdns.org:8282/">http://halfang.duckdns.org:8282/</a>

Click on the + sign at the top of the screen Navigate where the video file is located within your phone. No need to send this via email – we will get notified immediately and process the video file.
